The Bicycle Friendly Workshops work best when you have many different stakeholders around the table sharing what they're already doing to make cycling easier in your community, and discussing what they can do to create new programs or strengthen existing ones. With that in mind, below is a list of suggested invitees. Please note, this is by no means an exhaustive list – you may have stakeholders in your community that are also involved in the cycling conversation that should be invited, so feel free to expand on this list!

- Municipal and Regional Councillors – political representation is always important!
- Municipal staff – it is **very important** to have good representation from staff at the Workshop to ensure that the plans that emerge are realistic and supported by those within the municipality. Consider inviting staff from:
 - Engineering and Public Works
 - Planning
 - Parks and Recreation
 - Tourism
 - Economic Development
 - Environment and Sustainability
 - And any other departments that may be involved with promoting cycling in your community
- Public Health representatives – another very important stakeholder.
- School Board representatives
- Law Enforcement
- Regional Tourism Office
- Local cycling clubs
- Cycling advocacy groups
- Bike shop owners
- BIA and Chamber of Commerce representatives
- YMCA/recreation centres
- Local non-profits (United Way etc)
- Community Foundation representatives (if applicable)
